Program Rules

- Must meet all requirements of program standards, plus pre-approval by Waverly Utilities
- \$.20/square foot for spray foam insulation in all above-grade frame walls (**\$500 maximum**)
- \$.10/square foot for sealing of all penetrations into attic space (**\$300 maximum**)
- Rebates subject to availability of funds. Purchase and Installation must be between January 1 to December 31, 2020
- Waverly Utilities reserves the right to modify, amend or terminate rebate programs in whole or in part at any time for any reason without prior notice
- Waverly Utilities will inspect and verify installation
- Self-installed or "Do-it-yourself" projects – **NOT ELIGIBLE** (professional contractor must be used)

Program Requirements for Rebate Payment

- Project(s) must be paid in full prior to applying for rebate
- Itemized insulation receipts must include the following:
 - Contractor's name and address
 - Date of installation/service
 - Total labor cost
 - Description of area, including square footage of area insulated
 - Total material cost
 - Final R-Value

- 7) Reserves the right to end any cash rebate program at any time without notice. Incentives are available on a first come, first served basis. Neither pre-approval of a project, nor any other action by WU, entitles applicant to a rebate payment until and unless WU approves this application. Submission of a completed application does not guarantee an applicant or contractor will receive a rebate from WU.

Project eligibility:

All projects must obtain pre-approval from Waverly Utilities (WU) and be completed between January 1 and December 31, 2020. One rebate will be awarded per each installation address. If multiple installation addresses are at a single property, one rebate will be awarded per each installation address where WU separately meters the facility. Projects must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local codes, standards, and regulatory requirements. The most current rules of this program are posted at www.waverlyutilities.com. To evaluate your project, WU will reference the rules listed on the application form posted at www.waverlyutilities.com on the day WU receives your application.

Waverly Utilities Rebate Processing and Deadline Application:

Applications must be submitted no later than January 31, 2020. Please allow up to four weeks for rebate processing. Incomplete applications may be delayed or rejected.

Program Requirements for Rebate Payment:

Project(s) must be paid in full prior to applying for a rebate. Itemized insulation receipts from contractors must contain the following information, itemized separately for each separate project or category: itemized contractor's name and address date of installation/service, total labor cost, description of area including square footage of area insulated, total material cost, and final R-value.
